Figure 1.1: Marginal Returns to an Additional Educational Level - Males, 1983–2004

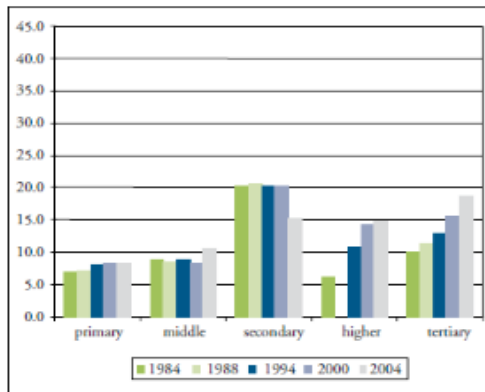
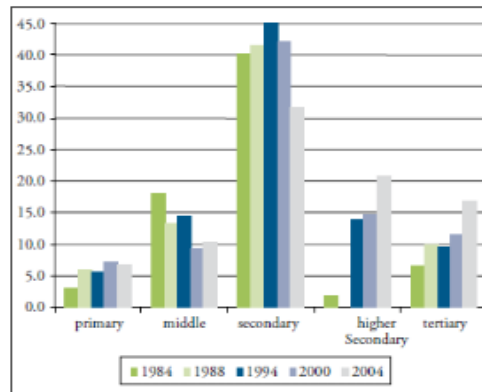


Figure 1.2: Marginal Returns to an Additional Educational Level - Females, 1983–2004
